# ASK THE PRINCIPAL



## Questions From Our Community Members To Our School Principal:

Q: As the leader of a large and diverse team, how do you handle internal disagreements in a way that upholds Islamic principles of consultation and unity, while still ensuring progress and accountability?

A: As an educational leader grounded in Islamic principles, I approach team management with wisdom, empathy, and a commitment to collective growth. When navigating internal disagreements, I'm guided by the timeless teachings of the Quran and the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him).

First and foremost, I make it a priority to actively listen to my team members. I carve out private, confidential spaces where individuals feel safe to express their concerns openly and vulnerably. Following the Prophet's example, I give them my full, undivided attention, making eye contact and reflecting back what I've heard to ensure I understand their perspectives clearly. This creates an atmosphere of trust and mutual respect.

Next, I facilitate structured consultations where all voices are heard. Rooted in the Quranic command to "conduct matters through consultation" (Surah Ash-Shura, 42:38), these meetings allow me to gather a diversity of insights before making decisions. I moderate the discussions skillfully, making space for healthy debate while guiding the team to focus on the issues at hand, not personalities.

Importantly, I don't view consensus as the end goal. Rather, I aim to make the best decision for the organization after carefully weighing the input. As the Prophet (peace be upon him) demonstrated, a leader must sometimes make tough choices, even if they don't align with everyone's preferences. The key is to do so with wisdom, transparency, and a spirit of unity.

Which brings me to the final step: closing ranks and moving forward together. I remind the team that we are all part of a greater whole, bound by our shared mission and Islamic values of mutual care and support. Just as the Prophet likened the believers to a single body, where "if one limb complains, the whole body responds with sleeplessness and fever" (Al-Bukhari), I expect my team to stand united behind the collective direction, even if individual opinions differ.

This principled approach has served me well in navigating the inevitable conflicts and disagreements that arise in large, diverse organizations. By modeling the virtues of listening, consultation, and unity, I cultivate an empowered, resilient team that is able to overcome challenges and achieve greatness. After all, as the Quran instructs, "And hold firmly to the rope of Allah all together and do not become divided." (Surah Aal-E-Imran, 3:103)

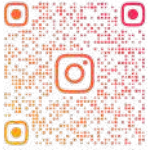

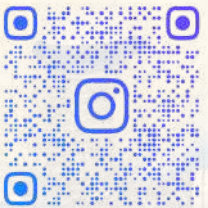

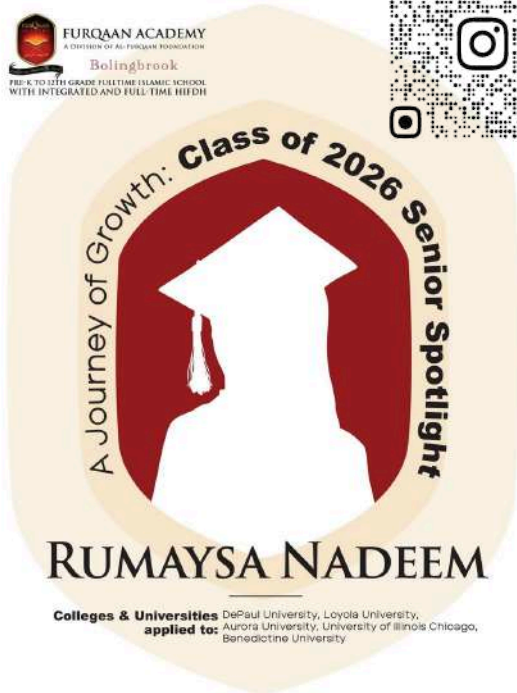
